Christian Conciliation and Arbitration Agreement

The parties to this agreement are Christian and believe that the Bible commands them to make every effort to live at peace and to resolve disputes with each other in private or within the Christian community in conformity with the Biblical injunctions of 1 Corinthians 6:1-8, Matthew 5:23,24 and Matthew 18:15-20. Therefore, the parties agree that any claim or dispute of the school relationship, including statutory claims, shall be settled by Biblically based mediation.

If resolution of the dispute and reconciliation do not result from such efforts, the matter shall then be submitted to a panel of three arbitrators for binding arbitration. Each party to the agreement shall have the right to select one arbitrator. The two arbitrators selected by the parties shall jointly select the neutral, third arbitrator. If there is an impasse in the selection of the third arbitrator, the Institute for Christian Conciliation in Billings, MT (406-256-1583) shall be asked to provide the name of a qualified person that will serve in that capacity. The arbitration shall be conducted in accordance with the Rules of Procedure for Christian Conciliation of the Institute for Christian Conciliation as printed in the Christian Conciliation Handbook.

The parties agree that these methods shall be the sole remedy of any controversy or claim arising out of the school relationship or this agreement and expressly waive their right to file a lawsuit against one another in any civil court for such disputes, except to enforce a legally binding arbitration decision.

Each party, regardless of the outcome of the matter, agrees to bear the cost of his/her/its own arbitrator and one-half of the fees and costs of the neutral arbitrator and any other arbitration expenses.

Parents' Agreement Form

We are a religious organization.

- 1. We consider it a privilege to have the opportunity to send our child to North Rome Christian School and shall endeavor to support and uphold the principles, practices, and educational policies of the school in every way.
- 2. We recognize that for our child to make good progress in his/her work, it is essential that he/she have confidence in his/her teacher and school. Therefore, we will do all in our power to see that our child respects and obeys the school staff and rules. We agree that if our child should become involved in any difficulty with other children or with a staff member, that with a prayerful Christian spirit we will register necessary complaints with the teacher or principal, while following the policies of Matthew 18.
- 3. We realize that a Christian school is not a substitute for the training, fellowship, and discipline of the local church. Therefore, we agree to have our child and family involved in a local church where the Bible, the ONLY Word of God is preached, believed, and obeyed.
- 4. We grant permission to the school authorities to discipline our child and to allow whatever disciplinary measures are necessary within the discipline policies that have been established for the school and are listed in the school handbook. Additional policies may need to be added and notices will be sent home to the parents. We further agree to cooperate and discipline our child at home, if necessary. We understand that any student is subject to review for dismissal by the school committee at any time. If our child is dismissed or withdrawn, the tuition costs will be recalculated to a per day figure for the number of days school has been in session. The difference between the amount already paid and the amount due will be the responsibility of the parents. Registration and Book Fees are not refundable.
- 5. We understand that students are accepted on a provisional status for the first nine week grading period.
- 6. We understand that permission slips for field trips and sports activities must be returned for my child to participate, and we absolve the school from any liability to us or our child because of any injury to our child at school or during a school activity.
- 7. We have read the following forms and agree to follow them: Parent's Financial Agreement, volunteer hours in lieu of \$450 fee, and the Christian Conciliation Agreement.
- 8. We have read the Student-Parent Handbook. We concur with it and agree to see that our child(ren) adheres to it. We have read the Statement of Faith and give our permission to the school to present this doctrine to our child(ren).
