## School Supplies 2023-2024

Supplies students will need for the FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL. Please purchase only \#2 USA Pencils. (Other types destroy the pencil sharpeners.)
Please label items, especially lunch pails and water bottles.

## ALL STUDENTS WILL NEED: A RED SHORT SLEEVE GCA LOGO T-SHIRT (required for fieldtrips and some events) <br> *Kindergarten*- (Miss. Holdren \& Mrs. Glowski)

1 Pencil Box. \#2 pencils (USA made only), erasers, washable markers, Crayola watercolor paints with paintbrush (8 or more colors), 3 glue sticks, crayons, scissors (sharp enough for a child to cut with and rounded edges), 2 cans of play dough. Individual dry-erase marker board and at least 2 dry-erase markers (you can get these from the dollar store). A mat for resting is provided but there is no space for pillows, covers, or stuffed animals. Anything extra for resting must be taken home on a daily basis. Be prepared to replenish supplies often. 3 boxes of tissues, and disinfectant wipes for cleaning tables would be appreciated. Please label each item individually. Initials are fine.

## *First Grade* (Mrs. Shanks \& Mrs. Searfoss)

8-12 \#2 pencils (USA made only), 1 composition notebook wide ruled, 1 one-inch 3-ring binder, 2 heavy duty (sturdy, plastic) folders, 1 package of 12 colored pencils, 1 package of 24 crayons, 1 pair of scissors, 3 glue sticks, 2 erasers, 1 self-contained pencil sharpener, Please DO NOT send in any markers or ink pens. The extra items seem to be a big distraction for the students. 3 boxes of tissues, and disinfectant wipes. (Additional notes for Mrs Searfoss class: 1 pk. Mechanical pencils with extra lead, 2 hard lid pencil boxes) (Additional notes for Mrs. Shanks class: she will provide a pencil box \& rulers she has in class)
*Second Grade* (Mrs. Clouse (\& Paraprofessional: Mrs. Jackie Vajda)
8-12 pencils (USA made only), 1 pack of mechanical pencils, cap erasers, 2 large erasers, highlighters, one package of 12 colored pencils, one package of 24 crayons, 1 pair of scissors, 2 glue sticks, $12^{\prime \prime}$ ruler with inches $\&$ metric, two (2) hard lid pencil boxes, 1 red sturdy plastic pocket folder, and 1 green sturdy plastic pocket folder. 1 composition notebook (no spiral bound please). 1 package of 100-sheet wide-ruled paper, three 1 " three-ring binders (hard cover please). Bible (NIV preferred for class), 3 boxes of tissue and disinfectant wipes.
*Third Grade* (Mrs. Wilson (\& Paraprofessional: Mrs. Karen Holdren)
8-12 pencils (USA made only) NO MECHANICAL PENCILS, Cap Easers and 2 large erasers, 3 Highlighter-Yellow, green, and blue, 1 package of 12 colored pencils , 1 package of 24 crayons, 1 pair of scissors, 2 glue sticks, $12^{\prime \prime}$ ruler with inch and metric, $\underline{2}$ hard lid pencil boxes, self-contained sharpener - no battery operated pencil sharpeners allowed, 4 sturdy plastic folders: 1 Red and 1 Green 2 other color/design, 2 Bound Composition notebooks (not spiral bound) any color/design, 1 pkg. 100-sheet wide ruled paper, 2-1" 3 ring binders (hard cover and any color/design), Bible. 3 boxes of tissues and disinfectant wipes.
*Fourth Grade* (Mrs. Hartman)
\#2 wood pencils (please none wrapped in plastic covering) no mechanical pencils please, erasers, colored pencils, 4 dry erase markers, 2 glue sticks, 1 pair of scissors, 2 pocket folders, 200 count of index cards, 2 composition notebooks, 2 packages of notebook paper, two 1-inch 3 -ring binders, a pencil box/ pouch, Bible (NIV is preferred as this is the version we will use for memory verses), student homework planner (assignment notebook), 3 boxes of tissues and disinfectant wipes.

## *Fifth Grade \& Sixth Grade Math, Social Studies \& Science * (Mrs. Cooper 5th Grade Homeroom \& 5th grade Bible class) *Sixth Grade \& Fifth Grade English Language Arts* (Mrs. Taylor: 6th Grade Homeroom \& 6th grade Bible class)

\#2 pencils (USA) and \#2 mechanical pencils with extra lead, erasers, 4 dry erase markers and 1 dry eraser, red, blue and black pens, colored pencils, 4 highlighters (pink, yellow, blue, green), scissors, 4 glue sticks, calculator, ruler: inch and metric, 1 pack of index cards, 6 composition notebooks (not spiral bound: 1 green, 1 yellow, 4 blue) , journal or notebook for Bible class, 2 note books (any kind for History \& Science) four 2-pocket folders (one red, one blue 2 of any color), 2 packages of lined loose-leaf paper, 3 1-inch 3-ring binder, a pencil box, Bible (NIV preferred-this is the version we will use for memory verses), 3 boxes of tissues and disinfectant wipes.

## *Seventh - Twelfth Grades* (Middle \& High school)

General Supplies: Student homework planner (assignment notebook), \#2 pencils (USA), erasers, colored pencils, blue \& black pens, red pens, highlighters, separate notebook for each subject, lined paper, post-it notes, folder for each subject, filler paper-LOOSE LEAF PAPER, , ruler (inch and metric), a thumb drive dedicated for school projects, book covers needed for each class (can be made), at least 1 pk of $3 \times 5$ lined index cards, 3 boxes of tissues and disinfectant wipes.
Class Specific Supplies:
Bible: A Bible (ESV, NIV, NASB,NKJV), highlighters, one folder with pockets.
History: one 1" 3-ring binder/notebook
English: one 2" 3-ring binder with dividers
Math: loose leaf paper \& graph paper in a 3-ring binder, (please do not use notebooks for filler paper due to the mess they make when torn out). A notebook, and scientific calculator (for Algebra I and above)
Science: 3" 3-ring binder for Science and Health Classes. Physical Science \& Chemistry will need a Scientific Calculator (TI 83, TI 85, or TI~Nspire) Colored Pencils(@ least 10 colors), highlighters (@ least 3 colors) Poster-board for projects throughout the year.
**Reminder about scientific calculators: SMARTPHONES ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE because some apps are considered cheating and will not be allowed in the classroom.
Please NO Trapper Keepers due to their size and bulk. Please choose items that have designs with a "Christian world-view". Inappropriate cartoons and "Hollywood teen" pictures and characters are not acceptable. No skull and crossbones or peace signs (upside-down broken cross) will be permitted.

All 7th-12th students will need their own assignment book to use for keeping track of daily assignments!
